1. Evaluating oratorical skill.

1.1 This oratorical skill will be assessed for the languages of Sinhala, Pali, Sanskrit, **English** and Tamil for all the four sectors in Pirivena. A competitor can represent for only one medium of language.

- *Only the competitors from pre-primary sector are allowed to speak on a prepared topic.*

This condition will be valid only for the languages of Pali, Sanskrit, Tamil and **English**.

1.2 Objectives

1.2.1 To raise the ability of fluency of speaking, reasoning and explaining gradually on a given topic and improving the preference of gathering information on various sectors.

1.2.2 To raise the competency of controlling audibility and using relevant postures.

1.3 Conditions for evaluation

1.3.1. Clear accurate pronunciation, situational posture and controlling audibility should be assessed.

1.3.2. Each competitor will be given **05 minutes** for preparation for the speech and the time allocation for the speech is also **05 minutes**.

1.3.3. Competitor should make the speech on the selected topic.

1.3.4. The decision of the bench is final.

1.3.5. The topics should be focused on the following themes for the national level.

- History of Sri Lanka
- Printed and Electronic Media
- Environment
- Science and Technology
- History of Sasana . (Sasana Ithihasaya)
- National Heroes
- Historical Heritages
- Globalization
- Buddhist Literature
- Literates.
