English Essay Writing

4.1 The evaluation will be conducted in all the five languages Sinhala, Pali, Sanskrit, **English** and Tamil. Sinhala, Pali, Sanskrit and **English** Essay writing evaluation will be conducted for all the four sections (Pre-Primary, Primary, Junior and Senior) and Tamil Essay writing evaluation will be conducted for other sections except Pre-Primary Section. One candidate will only be possible to participate for one language medium.

4.2 Goals and Objectives

4.2.1 To develop the ability to organize ideas in a grammatically coherent manner related to the topic.

4.2.2 To develop and to motivate to use writing skills by identifying different types of writing styles.

4.3 Evaluation Conditions

4.3.1 Pre-primary and primary candidates should write an essay of not less than 150 words on the given topic and junior and senior section candidates should write an essay of not less than 250 words.

4.3.2 The essay should be written in the respective language and Sanskrit candidates should use "*Nagari*" characters.

4.3.3 Time allotted to the candidates is 1 hour.

4.3.4 Attention should be paid to clear handwriting, spelling, paragraph spacing, and relevancy to the topic.

4.3.5 The decision of the bench is final.
